Re: COVID-19 and Sangerfest 2022

We have been asked to address our COVID policies with regard to Sangerfest 2022.

The Edvard Grieg Chorus continues to prepare for Sangerfest 2022. Our policy with regard to COVID is as follows:

- It is strongly advised that all NSAA members be vaccinated.
- Sangerfest 2022 will comply with all local, state and federal mandates with regard to COVID at the time of Sangerfest.
- As we don't know the extent of the necessary mitigating procedures for Sangerfest in June, we will send a list of procedures adopted to each NSAA chorus by June 1.
- The Marriott Hotel room reservations policy for attendees allows cancellation without charge if done no less than 48 hours prior to occupancy.

Because of the dramatic fall of the incidence of COVID, Madison and Dane County will drop the mask mandate as of March 1. At this point in time, it is difficult to predict exactly what the situation will be in June. However, the Edvard Grieg Chorus has made substantial financial commitments to host Sangerfest 2022 and will make every effort to provide a safe and secure Sangerfest.
